Meet Our Motorcycle Instructors



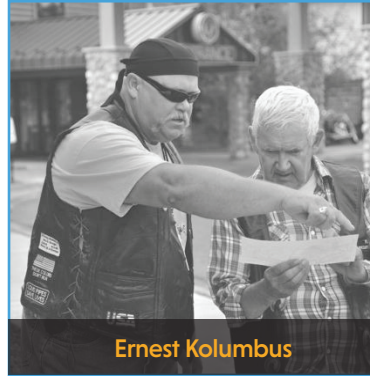
Judy Anderson

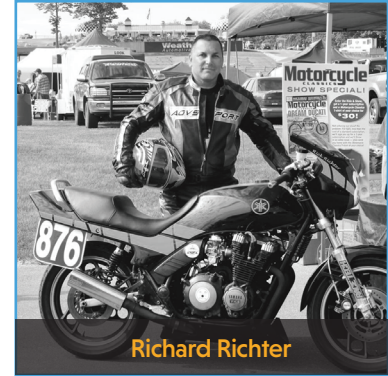
Tim Busse

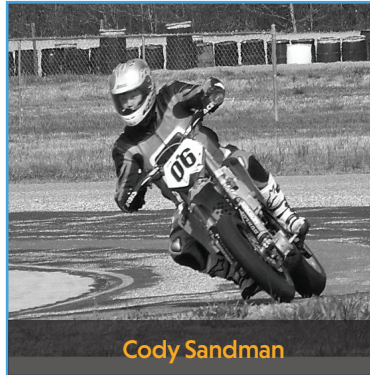
Richard Richter
