Types of Degrees:

- ❖ Associate of Arts
 - 61 Credits
 - Focus: Humanities & Social Science
- ❖ Associate of Science
 - 61 Credits
 - Focus: Math & Science

Transfer Potential:

- ❖ **University Transfer AA & AS degrees may satisfy General Education requirements for UW System schools.**
 - Note: Some UW schools and non-UW schools will only accept the Associate of Arts (not Associate of Science) as fulfilling the General Education requirements.
 - Note: If not taken as part of the AA/AS degree, General Education courses that are required for a major must be completed upon transfer
- ❖ **Guaranteed transfer to UW-Superior is available**
 - Students must sign and meet the requirements of the UW-Superior Guaranteed Transfer Agreement for guaranteed admission to UW-Superior
- ❖ **Degree completion does not guarantee transfer into a university (except UW-Superior under the Guaranteed Transfer Agreement) or major**

Partnership with UW-Superior:

- ❖ **Degree awarded by Northwood Tech**
- ❖ **Fin Aid through Northwood Tech → Fin Aid refunds sent to student → Student pays UW-Superior**
- ❖ **First 12 credits at Northwood Tech with 2.0 gpa**
- ❖ **Then dual admissions and enrollment at both Northwood Tech and UW-Superior**
- ❖ **Online Classes (UW-Superior); Online + Select Few Online Live Classes (Northwood Tech)**
- ❖ **Some Classes Only Available Through UW-Superior:** (Foreign Language, Health/Phy Ed, Higher Level Math, & Most Humanities)
- ❖ **Varied Tuition Rates: UW-Superior:** (Online Tuition Rate) approx. \$305/credit, plus \$16 segregated fees;
Northwood Tech: “10 level” classes approx. \$155/credit, “20 level” classes approx. \$200/credit

Student Fit for University Transfer Degree:

- ❖ Plan to Transfer to a University
 - **Note: For students who know that they want to attend Northwood Tech (not transfer to a university) and are undecided about what Northwood Tech program they want to pursue, the University Transfer degree may not be the best fit.**
 - Most University Transfer courses do not apply to most other Northwood Tech programs, and their general content is not likely to help a student identify a career skillset they want to pursue.
 - No clear goal tends to yield lower motivation, lower academic success.
- ❖ Have Strong Organization and Executive Functioning Skills
- ❖ Be Strong Independent Learners (online classes, select few Northwood Tech online live)
- ❖ Want/Need Online Classes
- ❖ Want Supportive Technical College Environment for Transition into College
- ❖ Want/Need Lower Credit Costs

University Transfer Degree (AA/AS) Admissions Process

1. **Submit Application to Northwood Tech for University Transfer – Associate to Bachelor's/Arts -or- Associate to Bachelor's/Science**
2. **Pay \$30 WITC Application Fee** (If Paid Within the Last 5 Years, No Fee is Required)
3. **Schedule & Complete Admissions Meeting** (Rice Lake Campus Call: 715-234-7082, ext. 5046)

Strongly Recommended Prior to Admissions Meeting

1. **Submit Official High School Transcript** (Review for Foreign Language Credit & Assist w/Class Placement)
2. **Submit Official College Transcripts for any College Classes Taken** (Transfer Credit Review)
3. **Submit AP Exam Scores, if applicable** (Must have scored 3 or higher on AP Exam)
4. **Submit ACT Scores, if applicable** (Assist w/Class Placement)
