

Step 2: Admission Requirements for ADN Program

- 1. Attain Accuplacer Next Gen entrance assessment scores of 263 required for admission to the ADN core program, unless already met in Step 1 or waived by providing an official transcript indicating a composite ACT score of 22 with a minimum Math ACT score of 18. If you hold an associate degree or higher no assessment is needed.
 - Proof of your associate degree or higher must be provided in the form of an official transcript.
- 2. Have earned a high school diploma or GED/HSED certificate; current high school seniors must provide both a current high school transcript and a final transcript with confer date.
 - Proof of your high school diploma or GED/HSED certificate must be provided in the form of an official transcript.
- 3. Complete one year of high school chemistry or one term of college-level chemistry with a 2.0 (C) or better.
- 4. Successful completion of a Nursing Assistant course with a grade of 2.0 (C) or better. You must provide documentation of completion of a course. It is *not necessary* to complete the national certification exam or be on the Nurse Aide Registry. Proof of your course completion can be provided by submitting one of the following:
 - Unofficial Northwood Tech transcript
 - Copy of CNA card
 - Copy of state registry
 - Other college transcript
- 5. General studies courses—when you petition, priority is given to students who have completed the ADN programrequired general studies courses as follows:

<u>Highest priority consideration will be given for the student who completes the following courses with a grade of 2.0 (C) or better:</u>

- 10806177 General Anatomy & Physiology*
- 10806179 Advanced Anatomy & Physiology*

<u>Second priority consideration will be given for the student who completes ADN Program-Required General</u> <u>Studies courses with a grade of 2.0 (C) or better **in the order listed**.</u>

- 10809188 Developmental Psychology
- 10801136 English Composition 1
- 10801196 Oral/Interpersonal Communications
- 10806197 Microbiology*
- 10809198 Introduction to Psychology
- 10809196 Introduction to Sociology
- 5 elective credits of any associate degree level or higher coursework
 - Recommended elective courses:
 - 10-501-101 Medical Terminology (3 credits)
 - 10-510-135 Anatomy, Physiology and Disease Concepts (2 credits)
 - 10-806-175 Pathophysiology (3 credits)
 - 10-804-138 Math for Health Professionals (2 credits)
 - Any management and/or leadership program coursework

*General Studies science courses are foundational to success in the ADN program. It is <u>highly</u> <u>recommended</u> that you retake these courses if they were completed more than five (5) years ago.

Financial Aid Note:

After a student has completed all their <u>required</u> Pre-ADN credits, there is no financial aid available until they are admitted and start the nursing program. For example, a student may want to take additional electives over the five electives required for the Pre-ADN program while waiting to be admitted into the nursing program. These additional electives will not be eligible for financial aid and a student will be required to self-pay for the additional electives taken.
