STUDENT POLICIES

WITHDRAWAL FROM MLT PROGRAM COURSEWORK

Northwood Tech student policy allows for the withdrawal from a course up until 80% of the course has been completed.

- A student may lose eligibility for financial aid the following term
- A student should meet with a Northwood Tech financial aid advisor before withdrawing
- A student should inform their instructor before withdrawing

If an MLT student withdraws from the same course two times, the two withdrawals will be considered a failure in that course. The two-withdrawal failure will then apply to the MLT fail/repeat policy.

MLT courses in each semester may be co-requisites of each other. If a student withdraws from a core (513-XXX) course where this applies, the student must withdraw from the applicable MLT core (513-XXX) courses in that semester.

Withdrawal Form

If you choose to withdraw from a course, be sure to complete the Withdrawal from the MLT Program form. This will help the program gather information regarding your decision to withdraw, which is useful in planning and improving the MLT program.
