STUDENT POLICIES

CRITERIA FOR SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE MLT PROGRAM

The MLT program requires 64 credits; 40 core credits (10-513-XXX) and 24 general studies credits.

It is expected that students master all course competencies. Grades are based on weighted percentages of course work located in the grading section of each course syllabus. Final grades are determined by using the weight and scores, not total points.

Learners must receive a C (79.5%) or higher in all required courses to continue in the Medical Laboratory Technician program. Scoring less than a C (79.5%) will require retaking the course and will delay progression in the MLT program. Learners must receive a C (79.5%) or higher in each required course, not only in 513-XXX (MLT) core courses. Course failures, repeats, and withdrawals will impact program progression including dismissal from the program. See failure, repeat, withdrawal, and dismissal policies.

In addition, certain course work in the MLT program must be completed with the specified percentage indicated in the course syllabus.

The criteria for successful completion of each course will be in the course syllabus.

MLT students must complete their degree within 5 years of the first successful completion of a 513-XXX core course.
