Students must also successfully pass all required course competencies. For specific program course requirements, see individual course syllabi. Failure to achieve a "C" in a course, failure to achieve the exam score as specified in the individual course syllabi or failure to pass all required course competencies will delay advancement in the program until an acceptable grade is achieved. Program courses may only be repeated once. If a course needs to be repeated, please contact your advisor before registering. This includes taking a similar course at another college.
