<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demonstrate negative status for tuberculosis (Tb) by the first day of class. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Provide two negative Mantoux Tests (skin tests) or one blood draw test (QuantiFERON®-TB Gold In-Tube test (QFT-GIT) or T-SPOT®. <i>TB</i> test (T-Spot)

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Submit Background Information Disclosure (BID) Form
