

Transfer Articulation Agreement
between
University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire
and
Northwood Technical College
in
Bachelor of Science in Professional Studies

The Bachelor of Science major in Professional Studies is designed in part to provide a pathway to a bachelor's degree for students who have completed an Associate of Applied Science degree from a Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) institution.

The 120-credit Bachelor of Science in Professional Studies includes a minimum of 36 credits in Liberal Education, 24 credits across one or two concentrations, and additional electives as needed to equal 60 total credits in the major. Students must earn 39 credits at the 300 or above level, and complete 18 of the last 30 credits at UW-Eau Claire.

UW-Eau Claire recognizes that successful completion of the A.A.S program at the WTCS college is sufficient evidence to warrant our acceptance of 60 credits towards the B.S. in Professional Studies.

Transferable general education courses offered as a part of the A.A.S program at the WTCS will be applied to relevant Liberal Education requirements at UW-Eau Claire. Course equivalencies have been pre-determined and are available in Transferology. Those that have not been determined may be reviewed on a case-by-case basis after a review of course syllabi. Any credits from the completed A.A.S not applicable to Liberal Education requirements will be credited toward the 120 credits required for completion of the B.S. degree.



If a student elects to change their major, any course with a direct transfer equivalent in Transferology will be transcribed and technical credits with no direct equivalent will not transfer into another program at UW-Eau Claire.

Students transferring from a WTCS college with an A.A.S. degree will need approximately 60 additional credits to complete the B.S. in Professional Studies at UW-Eau Claire. A student from a qualified A.A.S. degree program will typically transfer 6-12 credits of liberal education and 48-54 credits of electives (60 total credits will transfer, however the placement of credits will vary dependent upon the A.A.S. degree earned).

Students intending to complete the B.S. Professional Studies after completing an A.A.S at a WTCS institution are encouraged to contact the UW-Eau Claire transfer admission counselor at admissions@uwec.edu.

This articulation agreement applies only to the B.S. in Professional Studies major in effect 2024 fall semester, until revised. A change of major invalidates these course/credits for transfer

unless they are approved within some other program-to-program articulation agreement for another major at UW-Eau Claire.
