Blackboard

Blackboard is a learning management system where you will access course announcements, syllabus, assignments, and grades.

- > You may access Blackboard two weeks before the start of the classes. However, your instructor may not make your course material available until the first official day of class. STEP 1.

Create a MyNorthwoodTech account after you are admitted.

- > Select the **MyNorthwoodTech** link on the top of **NorthwoodTech.edu** and click on Continue to NorthwoodTech
- > Click on Sign on Assistance icon
- > Complete the fields and create a password with listed requirements
- > Sign into **MyNorthwoodTech** with a username (student Id#) and a new password

MyNorthwoodTech gives you access to:

- > Registration for classes
- > Requesting transcripts
- > View/Pay Tuition
- > Access your class schedule
- > View financial aid award and accept/decline loans offered
- > Set up a payment plan

Note: The password you created above for MyNorthwoodTech will be temporary until you can create a MyCampus password. **The MyCampus password will replace the MyNorthwoodTech password.**

STEP 2.

Create a MyCampus account

- > Create a **MyCampus** account after you create a **MyNorthwoodTech** account
- > The **MyCampus** link is on the top menu of **NorthwoodTech.edu**
- > Sign in with your Northwood Tech email address (first initial of your first name+last name+last four digits of your student ID number, i.e. jsmith1234@NorthwoodTech.edu)
- > Enter temporary default password (first two letters of first name, first two letters of last name, last four digits of student ID i.e. jism1234)
- > Create a new password with 13 or more characters
- > Follow the prompts to set up 2-factor authentication and password reset with **Microsoft Authenticator**
- > Scan the QR code to download the **Microsoft Authenticator** app. You must download and approve the app to access **MyCampus** apps and email.

> Online Live:

Microsoft TEAMS web conferencing is the platform used to attend class using the internet. A link will be available in Blackboard if web conferencing is a delivery option for your class.

> Innovative Teaching & Learning Center (iTLC) Services:

The iTLC is made up of three departments. All three departments are located together to give you one stop when you need assistance.

Learning Technology Center (LTC)

The LTC staff are technology experts. They offer assistance with Northwood Tech online applications, online resources for your classes, your computers or personal devices, software installs and much more. There is access to PCs with all the necessary software, printers, copiers, and scanners.

Library

To be eligible for student loans, your enrollment status must be at least half time as defined in the chart on the left. You **MUST** attend your classes to be eligible for financial aid.

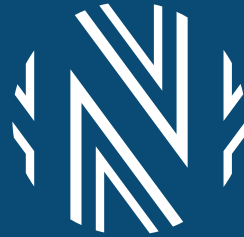
