STUDENT POLICIES

ADN GRADUATION AND NCLEX PROCESS

Students successfully completing the course requirements of the Northwood Tech ADN program with a grade of 2.0 or better are eligible to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN) to become licensed as a registered nurse. In addition, after successful completion of ADN Semesters 1 & 2, students are also eligible to take the NCLEX-PN (National Council Licensure Examination for Practical Nurses) to become licensed as a licensed practical nurse.

The national program codes for the Northwood Tech ADN program are:

- PN Program Code: US50100300
- RN Program Code: US50407200

Students who become LPNs remain eligible to continue in ADN Semesters 3 & 4 to earn an associate degree in nursing and be eligible to take the NCLEX-RN. If the student decides to work as an LPN after semester two, not enroll in semester three and then wants to return to the ADN program later, they will follow program reentry guidelines. Northwood Tech's process of conferring the students' degrees or adding the LPN milestone to transcripts may take up to 15 business days after final grades are entered to complete.

Wisconsin and Minnesota: Verifications of graduation will not be approved by the registrar until all campuses report the students' records have been completed and a report is run to confirm.

WI DSPS and MN Board of Nursing request an additional 3 weeks for processing after the Statement of Graduation or Completion forms have been received.

Allow at least six weeks after graduation/last day of classes for any inquiries about the Statement of Graduation or Completion submission to give Northwood Tech, DSPS, and MN BON time to process all the paperwork.
