Please carefully read the following information to help you apply, enroll, and begin the Northwood Technical College EMT program.

Step 1

Apply:

NorthwoodTech.edu/apply

(Be at least 17 years old by the end of the course to enroll)



Step 2

Register and pay:

Step 3

Gather your official immunization records and complete TB Testing.

TB Testing Required.

Options: 2-Step Mantoux (2 injections; 4 appointments) **OR** TB T-Spot (single blood draw)
OR QUANTiferon Gold (single blood draw).

Consider submitting these for optimal clinical placement:

- > Varicella
- > Tetanus
- > Hepatitis B
- > Flu Vaccine
- > MMR – Measles, Mumps and Rubella
- > COVID-19 Vaccine

Step 4

Attend TWO Orientations:

> **Mandatory: Online EMT Program Orientation**

Complete prior to your first day of class.

The orientation link is in your Blackboard course which is accessible 1 week prior to the start of class.

> **Highly encouraged: College Orientation**
