Class #: 27240 | **Cost:** \$49, \$34.38 (62+)

First Officer on Scene Fire EMS

Time: 1 p.m. – 5 p.m.

Discuss the similarity between fire and EMS incident tasks, and near-miss situation and how it might have been avoided.

I'm the New Training Officer... Now What? Fire

Time: 1 p.m. – 3 p.m.

Explore required training, joint-department training, minimal lecture and maximum skill sessions, scheduling, and securing needed resources and equipment.

Lessons Learned Fire EMS Law

Share experiences, ask questions, and learn from others about common incidents that can occur in the Northwood district.

Command Officers Toolbox Fire

Time: 3 p.m. – 5 p.m.

Focus on several attributes needed by both fire chiefs and fire command officers. Topics will include leadership and manage-

ment, size up and tactics, employee relations, and mental health issues. Group discussion/interaction on these topics is welcome.

Firefighter Hazards in Modern Building Construction Fire

Time: 3 p.m. – 5 p.m.

Review construction types and the advantages/disadvantages to firefighters, focusing on current construction methods, products, and changes. Explore use of newer lightweight materials, pre-engineered and manufactured components, and glues and metals that are not as heat resistant as advertised.

Hands-On Skills Sessions

Fun with Ropes & Ladders, Advanced Techniques Fire EMS

Time: 1 p.m. – 5 p.m. | **Class #:** 27241 | **Cost:** \$49, \$34.38 (62+)

How many ways can you use ropes and ladders to rescue someone from a structure? Rice Lake Fire Department Captain and Northwood Tech Fire/EMS Instructor Jeff Frank will lead this session in advanced rope and ladder rescue techniques. Basement, window, second story, balcony and through the floor rescues, are a few techniques students will work through. This session is outdoors using the campus training tower. Note: Participants are required to provide their own NFPA compliant PPE.

Firefighter Survival Fire

Time: 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. | **Class #:** 27246 | **Cost:** \$99, \$69.76 (62+)

Participants will be challenged with a realistic training environment based on most of the common hazards firefighters face today in structure fires or confined space activities. Note: NFPA compliant turnout gear and SCBA is required.

Grain Bin Rescue Fire EMS

Time: 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. | **Class #:** 27249 | **Cost:** \$99, \$69.76 (62+)

Learn practical skills and rescue techniques, including the basics on ropes, confined space entry, and responder safety using the multiple-purpose prop and featuring gravity grain box, grain bin, and auger offering great realism. Note: NFPA current PPE is required.

Rescue Me Fire EMS

Time: 10 a.m. – 5 p.m. | **Class #:** 27250 | **Cost:** \$75, \$53.07 (62+)

Learn a variety of off-road rescue scenarios; UTV/ATV/snowmobile rescue, river rescue, low angle rescue, off-road extrication, tree stand rescue and other basic rescue scenarios. With the parking lot as the staging area, students will determine the minimal equipment needed to carry/haul to the scene to perform each rescue scenario. Each scenario could lead to a full training session for your department's drill night. Note: Participants are required to provide their own NFPA compliant PPE.
