## **PROGRAM COMPLETION**

The Health Information Technology (HIT) program can be completed within two years. Students may, however, choose to complete the program at a part-time rate.

Because of course completion variations with incoming students, an HIT academic advisor will work individually with each student to develop a program completion sequence plan. Any questions regarding program/course sequencing should be directed to the student's academic advisor.

Program completion sequencing must follow pre/co-requisite requirements, as defined on the HIT curriculum checklist.

Part time sequencing can be sequenced into a 3- or 4-year plan. Four years is the maximum number of years a student may take to complete the HIT program. If at any time a student feels they may not meet this requirement, that student should request a meeting with their HIT academic advisor.
