TRANSFER CREDIT

Coursework taken to fulfill the program requirements outside of the Northwood Tech Health Sciences programs must meet all criteria of the program curriculum in terms of degree credit level, equivalent credit hours, and equivalent course competencies.

At least 25 percent of technical studies credits in an associate degree program, 25 percent of occupational-specific credits in a technical diploma program, or 25 percent of technical certificate credits must be earned at Northwood Tech to be eligible for graduation from the College. ^{*} A minimum of 25% of the students' first year core nursing technical studies courses must be completed at Northwood Tech to receive the PN Milestone transcript notation and have eligibility to sit for PN NCLEX.

Courses taken within the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) with a grade of "C" (2.0) or higher are acceptable.

Students are highly encouraged to repeat general studies science courses completed more than five years ago.

Students wishing to transfer credits from other accredited academic institutions must meet the requirements and follow the procedure outlined in the Northwood Tech Student Handbook, under Credit for Prior Learning. Contact your academic advisor for assistance in requesting Credit for Prior Learning.

Core nursing coursework completed at other non-WTCS colleges and transferred in to fulfill Northwood Tech's ADN program requirements must also have program accreditation from Accreditation Committee for Education in Nursing (ACEN) or the Nursing Commission for Nursing Accreditation (CNEA) at the time the courses were taken.

A student who wants to take an ADN course from another WTCS school of nursing must seek approval from the ADN Nurse Administrator by completing the TRANSFER OF STUDENT ACADEMIC STANDING INFORMATION PERMISSION AND STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING form (E-03-ADN Student Policies). The ADN Nurse Administrator will confirm the student's good academic standing and email the course instructor at the other WTCS college for this approval.

If the student does not disclose that they are taking the course at another WTCS college and withdraws from or does not successfully complete the course, this will be considered "Academic Dishonesty" and will constitute a violation of the Health Sciences Code of Conduct (HS-ii) and college Academic Misconduct Policy (see Northwood Tech Student Handbook->Student Behavior Expectations->Academic Misconduct Policy).

If the student completed core coursework at a non-WTCS college, the following procedure is used: The program director conducts the official review of core program coursework for transfer credit. In addition to the official transcripts, students must submit course syllabi, course assignments, and related course materials so that a careful and complete assessment of previous coursework can be performed to ensure the program accreditation standards, competencies, and requirements of the program courses are met.

Prior failure of or withdrawal from any transferred course will be considered the same as a course taken in the Northwood Tech HS program, and the Repeat Course/Failure/Dismissal policy will apply.

**To maintain the integrity, consistency, and quality of instruction in alignment with accreditation standards and the unique structure of the Surgical Technology Program, the core program courses listed are not eligible for transfer credit from other institutions. These courses are integrated with specific apprenticeship-based delivery methods, employer partnerships, and direct alignment with program competencies that require consistent evaluation without our own instructional framework.

This policy for Surgical Technology ensures that all students receive consistent, high-quality instruction and are evaluated under the specific requirements of our accredited model. Transfer credit for general education courses will continue to be considered in accordance with Northwood Technical College's transfer policies.
