FAILING GRADES

Any of the following may result in or contribute to a failing grade in an MCS program course:

- 1. Failure to attain at least a grade of C in the course
- 2. Failure to complete all course requirements
- 3. Academic dishonesty
- 4. Failing to submit assignments
- 5. Consistently submitting assignments after the due date

MCS students are required to obtain a grade of C or better in all MCS program courses, including science, general studies, and elective courses required. All required coursework from each semester, including semester-required science and general studies courses, must be successfully completed (grade of C or higher) before the student may take coursework from subsequent semesters.
