STUDENT POLICIES

FAILING GRADES

Any of the following may result in or contribute to a failing grade in an MCS program course:

1. Failure to attain at least a grade of C in the course
2. Failure to complete all course requirements
3. Academic dishonesty
4. Failing to submit assignments
5. Consistently submitting assignments after the due date

MCS students are required to obtain a grade of C or better in all MCS program courses, including science, general studies, and elective courses required. All required coursework from each semester, including semester-required science and general studies courses, must be successfully completed (grade of C or higher) before the student may take coursework from subsequent semesters.
