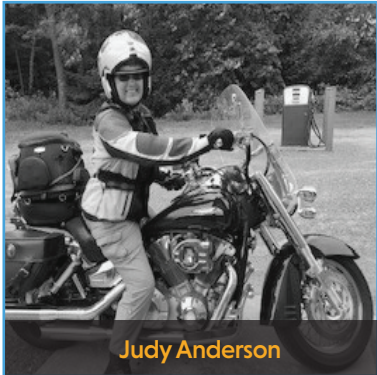




Learn From The Best

Meet Our Motorcycle Instructors



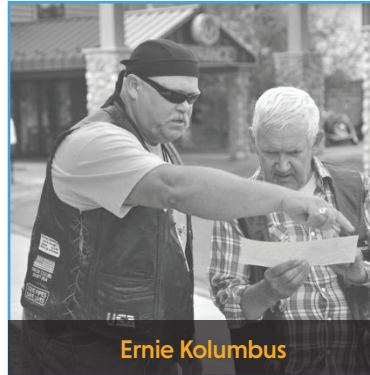
Judy Anderson

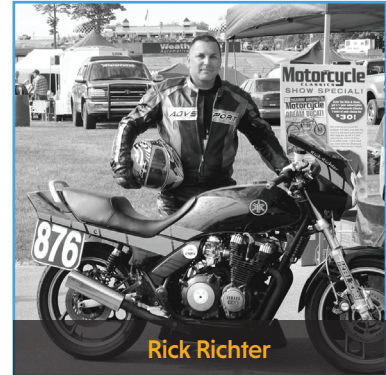
Maria Herdahl

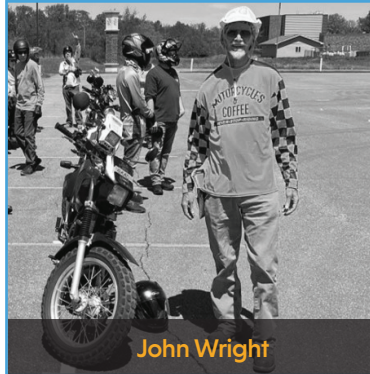
Rick Richter
