WITHDRAWAL FROM SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM COURSEWORK

Northwood Tech student policy allows for the withdrawal from a course up to 80% of the course has been completed.

Notes:

- A student may lose eligibility for financial aid in the following term
- A student should meet with a Northwood Tech financial aid advisor before withdrawing
- A student should inform their program director before withdrawing
- A student should inform their apprenticeship sponsor before withdrawing

Withdrawal from Surgical Technology program courses is discouraged and should only occur under extenuating circumstances that prevent the Surgical Technology student from finishing the semester successfully.

Since Surgical Technology courses in each semester are corequisites of each other, if a Surgical Technology student withdraws from one core (512-xxx) course, the student must withdraw from all Surg Tech core (512-xxx) courses in that semester.

Withdrawing from required coursework will lead to a delay in completion of the program. Surgical Technology core (512-xxx) courses are offered in select semesters and sequence.

Withdrawal Form

If you choose to withdraw from a course, be sure to complete the “Withdrawal from the Surgical Technology Program” form. This will help us gather information regarding your decision to withdraw, which is useful in Surgical Technology planning processes.
