Nursing – Associate Degree to BS Health Science (Allied Health Focus). Eligible Nursing – Associate Degree graduates can transfer up to 59 credits into the BS Health Science (Allied Health Focus) program; 32 credits remain to complete the 91 credit degree at WGU.

Nursing – Associate Degree to BS and Post Baccalaureate Certificate Nursing – RN to MSN track (CCNE ACEN or NLN CNEA accredited). Eligible Nursing – Associate Degree graduates can transfer up to 83 credits into the BS and Post Baccalaureate Certificate Nursing – RN to MSN track program; 35 credits remain to complete the 118 credit degree at WGU.

Nursing – Associate Degree to BS Nursing (RN to BSN) – CCNE ACEN or NLN CNEA accredited. Eligible Nursing – Associate Degree graduates can transfer up to 83 credits into the BS Nursing (RN to BSN) – CCNE ACEN or NLN CNEA accredited program; 37 credits remain to complete the 118 credit degree at WGU.
