# Northwood Tech offers CDL Permit Prep courses!

## Must meet and/or provide the first day of class:

- ☐ 18 years of age or older
- ☐ Verification of valid driver's license
- ☐ Verification of DOT physical exam and FMCSA Pre-Emploment drug

Health care providers and many chiropractors can provide this exam. Students should state that they are in need of a DOT physical exam when making the appointment.

☐ Copy of CDL Class A permit with air brakes

To obtain a permit, students need to pass three written tests at their nearest Wisconsin Department of Transportation office. Although there is no fee to take the tests, there is an additional fee for the CDL Permit. The test includes:

- 1. General Knowledge
- 2. Air Brakes
- 3. Combination Vehicles

### **CDL Permits**

To obtain a Commercial Learner Permit (CLP), you will need to pass written tests at a Wisconsin Department of Transportation office. The CLP costs \$30. There is no cost to take the permit tests.

### The test includes:

- 1. General Knowledge-5 attempts
- 2. Air Brakes-5 attempts
- 3. Combination Vehicles-5 attempts (Not required for Class B)

**Do not use all 5 attempts** before contacting a Northwood Tech instructor or you will have to wait one calendar year to retake.

Tests can be taken individually by section. CLP is good for 6 months/180 days. Please refer to the manual to study for the test at <a href="https://wisconsindot.gov/Documents/dmv/shared/bds356-cdl-manual.pdf">https://wisconsindot.gov/Documents/dmv/shared/bds356-cdl-manual.pdf</a>

## **CDL Class A** (Technical Diploma)

9-week/9 credit program with multiple start dates

Employers are seeking drivers who have completed the technical diploma, which includes Levels 1 – 3

Northwood Tech highly encourages students to complete all levels for employability

## **CDL Class B** (Continuing Education)

40 hours with flexible scheduling

# **Requirements**

Admission requirements must be met before the first day of class.

Prospective students need to allow time to study for the permit tests and schedule a physical exam and drug test including receiving results.
