to

## The University of Wisconsin-Superior (UWS) Elementary Education Early Childhood Track Bachelors Degree

#### Introduction and Rationale:

The University of Wisconsin-Superior maintains an educational partnership with The Wisconsin Technical Colleges to provide opportunities for students to enter bachelor's degree completion programs. In the interest of fostering cooperation between our institutions and to better serve the transfer of students from Wisconsin Technical Colleges to the University of Wisconsin-Superior, the faculty and administration of our institutions have established this articulation agreement.

This Agreement specifies the transfer of credit from the WTCS Associate of Applied Science Degree named above to the UWS Bachelor's Degree named above in recognition that the WTCS program prepares students for admission to this Bachelor's Degree program. The underlying assumption for such an agreement is that the technical college provides a foundation of coursework, and the university provides the upper-level courses required within the Bachelor's Degree program.

WTCS students who successfully complete the Associate of Applied Science Degree named above and wish to transfer to the University of Wisconsin-Superior Elementary Education Early Childhood Track with their minor in Early Childhood Education will be awarded the following credits toward a B.S. Degree in Elementary Education: Early Childhood Track with an Early Childhood Minor.

This articulation does not list all the courses that WTCS students might take as part of their WTCS Associate of Applied Science Degree that could transfer to UW-Superior and reduce the number of credits required at UW-Superior but focuses on those required by the ECE AAS program. \*Students must complete University Studies courses in Math, Environmental Science, and Lab Science categories. The listed classes will each fulfill one category; only one class is required by the WTCS ECE program. Students will need to complete the remaining two categories.

\*\*Licensure candidates must fulfill an Environmental Science course for DPI requirements. The listed course will fulfill the requirements if taken as part of the WTCS ECE program.

<sup>2</sup> Both classes must transfer together to transfer as ECED 353.

#### Requirements

Admission to UW-Superior: Students from WTCS must have completed the above-named program with a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 for consideration for transfer to UW-Superior under the terms of this document. Admission to the Teacher Education program requires a 2.75/4.0 Honors GPA.

Admissions to Teacher Education: Admissions to UW-Superior does not guarantee admissions to the Teacher Education Program/Elementary Education Major Early Childhood Track. Students must pass a Criminal Background Check and provide a recent documentation of a negative tuberculosis test. Students must also achieve an honors grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 in all of their collegiate coursework. For more information see the most up-to-date UW-Superior Catalog: Admissions to Teacher Education.

**University Studies:** WTCS General Education/breadth courses in social sciences, communications, mathematics, writing, and natural science may transfer in to fulfill some of UW-Superior's University Studies requirements. All University Studies requirements not met by transfer credits must be completed for graduation.

Major Credits: 46 credits are required to complete the Elementary Education Major Early Childhood Track.

**Minor Credits**: An Early Childhood Minor of at least 21 credits must be completed with this Major. The Early Childhood Education Program at WTCS (39 credits) transfers in as 12 credits and requires 9 more credits specifically from ECED and EGNED to complete the UWS Early Childhood Education Minor.

**Electives:** Elective WTCS courses not listed above will be reviewed with the UW System Transfer Information System or by the UW-Superior faculty on a case-by-case basis.

**Program Completion**: Students are required to complete a final project (the Elementary Education major requires 12 credits of appropriate student teaching in the schools) to be eligible for the Elementary Education degree. Students must have an Honors GPA of 2.75/4.0 to move into Student Teaching Residency. The Wisconsin DPI requires that licensure candidates must pass the Assessments of Content Knowledge, DPI-approved program completion literacy training assessments, and successfully complete the Assessments of Pedagogical Knowledge.

General Degree Requirements: In order to be awarded a degree from UW-Superior, students are required to earn:

- 120 total credits to complete the bachelor's degree named above,
- at least 30 credits at UW-Superior,
- at least 36 credits in upper-division courses (300-400 level), and
- their final 12 credits through UW-Superior.

#### **Conditions:**

The terms of this articulation agreement apply only for the purposes of entry to the Bachelor of Science Degree in Elementary Education-Early Childhood Track at the University of Wisconsin-Superior. WTCS students seeking admission to other degree programs offered at UW-Superior may transfer to the University only those credits recognized under the current UW System-Transfer Guidelines as documented on the Transfer Information System website at <a href="https://www.wisconsin.edu/transfer/">https://www.wisconsin.edu/transfer/</a>.

This Agreement is limited to UW-Superior's requirements for completion of a Bachelor's Degree in Elementary Education-Early Childhood Track only and reflects current catalog and Wisconsin licensure requirements. The state licensure requirements can change due to state or federal legislation at any time. Students seeking certification for Birth- 3<sup>rd</sup> grade licensure must complete any additional requirements for such certification, and those requirements supersede the requirements in this articulation.
