- Minimum 120 semester credits; minimum 40 upper division credits (at or above the 3000 level)
- Last 30 credits taken at The College of St. Scholastica; minimum 16 credits in the major

General Education Requirements for the BS Degree

Most HIT associate degree programs include courses that fulfill some of the general education requirements for the BS degree (e.g., Natural Science). Students may complete remaining general education courses at Scholastica or they may transfer coursework to satisfy all of the lower division general education requirements and complete the two required St. Scholastica Integrations courses at St. Scholastica.

The College of St. Scholastica accepts the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC), Arizona General Education Curriculum (AGEC), or a previously completed AA or BA degree to fulfill the Veritas General Education requirements for the online HIIM program, except for a religious studies and upper division Integrations course.

Students are not required to have all general education requirements completed prior to admission to the program. Students are encouraged to contact a St. Scholastica admissions counselor early for questions regarding Veritas transfer options.
