FAILING GRADES

Any of the following may result in a failing grade in an ADN course:

- 1. Failure to attain at least a grade of "C" (80%) in the course
- 2. Failure to meet clinical performance expectations
- 3. Failure to complete all course requirements
- 4. Academic dishonesty
- 5. Failure to meet all safety precautions

ADN students are required to obtain a grade of "C" (80%) or better in ADN prerequisite, elective, and program courses. A minimum of C (2.0) is required in both General Anatomy and Physiology and Advanced Anatomy and Physiology.

All required coursework from each semester, including semester-required science and general studies courses, must be successfully completed before the student may take coursework from subsequent semesters.
