GRADING

Grading Scale and Rounding Rules:

The ADN program grading scale is the same as the WITC college-wide grading scale, Academic Standards procedure I-510A. Grades are based on percentages of assigned, weighted assessments and other learning activities as determined by the instructor and documented in the course syllabus.

NOTE: The ADN program requires that students must earn a grade of “C” (80%) or higher in all required program courses. Grades below a “C” (80%) are considered a failing grade. Grades of less than a “C” (80%) will be assigned in order to assist in Financial Aid processes, but still considered as failing in the program.

Rounding Less than Whole Percentage Numbers to Determine Grade

If the final percentage is less than a whole number, the grade will not be rounded. Students must achieve a minimum of 80% to pass the course.

Required Percentage to Pass Courses in the ADN Program

An eighty percent (80%) average is required to receive a passing grade of “C” for any course required in the Associate Degree Nursing program. This requirement includes General Studies courses and electives, with the exception of General and Advanced Anatomy and Physiology;

these courses require a B-. Any grade percentage below 80% is considered course failure in the ADN program.

The final course average may be rounded to the **tenth place IN THE GENERAL STUDIES COURSES ONLY**. For example a course average of 79.50% would be rounded to 80% and be a passing average; a course average of 79.49% would be rounded to 79% and would not be a passing average. In the core ADN program, grades **WILL NOT** be rounded. A student must achieve a minimum score of 80% to pass the course.
