I. Introduction

This school-to-school articulation agreement establishes a formal agreement between all Wisconsin Technical College System institutions and Concordia University Inc. It is based on a review and analysis of the curriculum from the schools in the Wisconsin Technical College System in relation to the Baccalaureate curriculum at Concordia University Inc.

This agreement will facilitate the transfer of credits earned by qualified students of the Wisconsin Technical College System into a Baccalaureate degree program at Concordia University Inc. by guaranteeing the transferability of academic coursework that constitutes part of the successful completion of an Associate Degree, an Associate of Arts (AA) or Sciences (AS), Associate Degree of Applied Arts (AAA) or Applied Sciences (AAS) from a Wisconsin Technical College System Institution.

II. Terms of the Agreement

Because these transfer agreement provisions are used in transfer agreements with several Technical Colleges, the term "Technical College" will be used to refer to the specific colleges named at the bottom of this transfer agreement and colleges covered listed as WTCS schools.

- A. Qualified students who meet the admission criteria of Concordia University Inc. and are admitted under the Advanced Transfer Core are guaranteed transferability of academic courses of up to 84 credits of D or above earned at a Wisconsin Technical College System institution.
- B. Qualified students are those who have completed the Associate Degrees, Associate of Arts (AA) or Sciences (AS), Associate Degree of Applied Arts (AAA) or Applied Sciences (AAS)
- C. If a qualified student has transferee credits into a Wisconsin Technical College System institution, and those credits form a part of the Wisconsin Technical College System's degree, a transcript from the original school must also be submitted and evaluated separately.
 - i. To earn a baccalaureate degree the student must earn a minimum total of 120 credits and comply with all graduation requirements as specified in the Concordia University Inc. catalog for undergraduate programs. Students must complete and satisfy the program residency requirements at Concordia University Inc.
- D. Students who fail to meet the requirements outlined in point B are not guaranteed transferability of all the course works as outlined in this agreement. Their credits will be the Agreement. Their credits will be evaluated on an individual basis.
- E. Some academic programs at Concordia University Inc. have more prerequisites or higher GPA requirements than others. As such, students wishing to major in these programs with additional requirements will have their credits evaluated on an individual basis.

- F. An active agreement begins at the commencement of classes. The agreement must be actively reviewed by the program faculty of all WTCS schools and renewed at least every two years to continue the agreement. Reasonable accommodations will be made for students if either program must be changed, but additional courses may be required of students if the program changes. Students must be informed of this possibility "upfront."
- G. This agreement does not guarantee a student's acceptance into CU Inc.'s program.
- H. Each institution is responsible for notifying the other of any changes in the program or curriculum.
- I. The Parties will abide by confidentiality requirements outlined in the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (20 USC § 1232g ("FERPA") and other applicable laws.

III. The Agreement

All parties agree to provide at least one hundred eighty (180) days advance written notification of their intent to cancel this agreement. Students who apply to CU INC. before the cancellation date will be permitted to transfer credits under the agreement terms. All parties further agree that failure to maintain regional accreditation required by the specific academic program(s) referenced in this agreement will be grounds for exclusion of that program from the agreement.
