FAILING GRADES

Any of the following may result in a failing grade in a DA program:

- 1. Failure to attain at least a grade of "C" (2.0 or higher) in any DA course
- 2. Failure to meet clinical performance expectations
- 3. Failure to complete all course requirements
- 4. Academic dishonesty
- 5. Failure to meet all safety precautions

DA students are required to obtain a grade of "C" (2.0 or higher) in all DA program courses. All required coursework from each semester, including general studies courses, must be successfully completed with a grade of "C" (2.0 or higher) before the student may take coursework from subsequent semesters.
