FAILING GRADES

Any of the following may result in or contribute to a failing grade in an HIT program course:

- 1. Failure to attain at least a grade of "C" in the course
- 2. Failure to meet professional practice experience expectations/policies
- 3. Dismissal from a professional practice experience site
- 4. Failure to complete all course requirements
- 5. Academic dishonesty
- 6. Failing to submit assignments
- 7. Consistently submitting assignments after the due date

HIT students are required to obtain a grade of "C" or better in all HIT program courses, including science, general studies, and elective courses required. All required coursework from each semester, including semester-required science and general studies courses, must be successfully completed (grade of "C" or higher) before the student may take coursework from subsequent semesters.
