

















Fiscal Year: July 1 to June 30. This includes Summer, Fall, and Spring academic terms.

**Registration Year:** The registration year refers to the academic year that students are registering for classes. Registration year reporting starts at the beginning of March.

**Registration Week**: The number of weeks since Registration Year reporting began. Week 1 is at the beginning of March. Northwood Tech students typically begin registering for fall courses in April.

**FTE:** The measure of a full-time equivalent student is based on a standardized number of credits. The standard is 30 credits per year.

**Actual FTE:** The credits of the student is based upon the total credits enrolled and the start date of the class is equal or less than today's date.

**Headcount based on Actual FTE**: The number of students (headcount) who are actually attending a class that has started, as of the current date or before.

**Registered FTE**: The credits of the student is based upon the total credits registered and considered enrolled. (Credits Registered / 30 credits = Registered FTEs)

UGRD: Academic career indicating an undergraduate student

**EXED**: Academic career indicating an adult basic education student

Credit: UGRD + EXED combined

**CNED** (also known as **Non-Credit**): Academic career indicating a continuing education student. Includes three categories: General Adult, Occupational Adult, and Adult Avocational.

**Transcripted Credit**: Students by term that have a Recognized Credit Code of 1A (Advanced Standing/Tech Prep), 1B (Advanced Standing/Youth Appren), 8A (AB94-05 Transcript/Tech Prep) or 8B (AB94-05 Transcript/Youth Apprn) for a course.

**New-To-College Students**: Identifies students that are new to the college and took a course within the identified year. They were not previously at the college.

Graduates: The unduplicated count of graduates who received a degree or credential

**Credentials**: Credentials are the degrees, diplomas, or certificates earned by students. In this report, the number of credentials is a duplicated count of graduates because graduate may receive more than one credential in each term

**Degree-Seeking**: UGRD students who are enrolled in a program and working towards a specified credential

Full-Time: Students attempting 12 or more credits in a term

Part-Time: Students attempting less than 12 credits in a term
