Northwood Technical College has a procedure for students to appeal institutional decisions that affect their academic standing or progress in:

- Final course grades.
- Credit for prior learning.
- Satisfaction of graduation requirements.

Students and staff should make every attempt to resolve the issue through an informal review, which is required prior to the submission of a request for a formal appeal. In the case of a formal appeal, an Academic Appeals committee will be formed to investigate. The decision of that committee is final.
