

Duplicate Diploma Fee \$10.00 for each reprint

By Board action, in accordance with Wisconsin State Statute, Chapter 38, §38.24(3)(f), the College waives the charging of out-of-state tuition for Internet courses and will charge the standard in-state fees. In accordance with Administrative Bulletin 99-13, the Board delegates the College president or designee to submit this action for the setting of the fee to the state board office for approval as a standing rate. Needy and worthy out-of-state tuition remission provision, Wisconsin State Statute, Chapter 38, §38.24(3)(c)(1); WTCS Administrative Bulletin 04-02, to assist victims of hurricanes.
