FAILURE/COURSE REPEAT POLICY

Medical Coding Specialist students may repeat a program curriculum course only **once**. In addition, students enrolled in the MCS program may repeat only **two** courses in their program during their progress toward graduation.

If a student has experienced a failure in an MCS curriculum course, and plans to take the course again, they must pass the course during the second attempt. If a student fails the same course a second time, they will be dismissed from the MCS program.

If a student fails three or more different MCS program curriculum courses, that student will be dismissed from the MCS program.
