

WITHDRAWAL FROM OTA PROGRAM COURSEWORK

WITC student policy allows for the withdrawal from a course up until 80% of the course has been completed.

Notes:

- A student may lose eligibility for financial aid the following term
- A student should meet with a WITC financial aid advisor before withdrawing
- A student should inform his/her instructor before withdrawing

Withdrawals from OTA program courses is discouraged and should only occur under extenuating circumstances, which prevent the OTA student from finishing the semester successfully.

If an OTA student or Pre-OTA student withdraws from the same course two times, the two withdrawals will be considered a failure in that course. The two withdrawal failure will then apply to the OTA fail/repeat policy.

Since OTA courses in each semester are co-requisites of each other, if a student withdraws from one core (514-xxx) course, the student must withdraw from all OTA core (514-xxx) courses in that semester.
