

STRATEGIC PRIORITY Re-Evaluation Process

The EVOLVE XXIII 2021-2023 Strategic Plan was developed during the COVID-19 pandemic. Many unknowns existed during this period. As such, the decision was made to create a shorter, two-year strategic plan followed by a re-evaluation of the plan. The shorter strategic planning cycle allows for Northwood Tech to adjust based on emerging information about the postpandemic "new normal."

A process has been developed to re-evaluate the priorities of the 2021-2023 Strategic Plan. Through the process, it will be determined which strategic actions need to be extended into the future and which need to be retired. Additionally, new strategic actions will also be considered. The re-evaluation of priorities will be completed by December 2023, extending the strategic plan through 2027. A timeline of the process can be found below.
