LEARNING COMMONS

Academic Support Center: The Academic Support Center (ASC) supports you as you work to maximize your full academic potential. The ASC collaborates with faculty, staff, and other campus partners to provide a range of services, programs, and resources to support your learning. Support is student-centered, accessible, inclusive, and free of charge.

Tutors: Peer tutors are available through the Academic Support Center for additional one-on-one assistance. In addition to strengthening your understanding of course material, tutors will assist you in identifying subject areas to study or practice.

Academic Coach: Academic Coaching is available for students to learn more about managing time, learning styles and strategies, study skills or strategies, accountability, test-taking strategies, test-taking anxiety, note taking strategies, and more. Academic Coaching is free and available for all students by recommendation.

Educational Technology Center: Educational Technology Center (ETC) staff are available to provide hands-on support. You will have access to a computer lab that has all the software necessary to be a successful student at WITC, as well as printers, copiers, and scanners.

Learning Resource Center: Learning Resource Center (LRC) staff are onsite to help you find the information you are looking for and help you bring that information into your work. Stop into the LRC for access to computers, printers, scanners, books, journals, newspapers, and research help.

Math, Science, and Writing Labs: The Math, Science, and Writing Labs provide an opportunity to work with teaching specialists on a virtual drop-in basis. When attending the labs, please have your assignments, homework, and questions ready. The Math, Science, and Writing Labs are available to all students.

Math Success: Based on your interest or instructor or counselor recommendation, you can receive additional help and support from your math teacher either before or after your math class. The times and days vary depending on the math class. Please work with your math instructor to participate in Math Success.

Writing Essentials: This free course provides additional clarification and support from your instructors in Writing/English up to 2 hours/ week, varies based on your individual needs.
