Position Summary:

Nicolet College, in partnership with Wisconsin Indianhead Technical College (WITC), is establishing a pool of qualified candidates to be considered when adjuncts or substitute instructors are needed to teach Spanish courses at WITC. Courses may be taught from any of the four campuses (New Richmond, Rice Lake, Superior, or Ashland).

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

The following duties are normal for this position. These are not to be construed as exclusive or all-inclusive. Other duties may be required and assigned.

- Deliver performance-based, learning-centered instruction in accordance with the mission, vision, and philosophy of Nicolet College.
- Use educational technologies for teaching, learning, assessment, online/distance learning, and student record keeping (ex: learning management systems, teleconferencing systems, textbook digital learning environments).
- Communicate regularly and provide consistent feedback to students about successful course completion.
- Maintain accurate attendance, student success, and scholastic records of students and submit required reports according to published deadlines.
- Communicate with full-time instructors and the dean regarding instruction and student performance.

Required Qualifications:

- Master's Degree or higher in Spanish or Master's Degree in a closely related field with a minimum of 18 graduate credits in Spanish is required. Certification from the Defense Language Institute in Spanish will meet the educational requirements.
- Near native fluency in Spanish.
- Demonstrated ability to teach.
- Demonstrated ability to work both independently and collaboratively to create and facilitate student learning.

- Ability to communicate effectively with people from diverse backgrounds and maintain positive working relationships across the College and in the district.
- Ability to meet and maintain Nicolet College Faculty Quality Assurance System requirements.
