WHICH STUDENTS ARE ELIGIBLE:

• Eligible Programs include: Nursing Assistant

• There are no income requirements for WisCaregiver Careers. Trainees can be sourced from the employers' incumbent workers, from employers community sourcing methods, or FSET (which does carry income requirements). Students do not need to be eligible under FSET to participate in this program, FSET is simply the agency assisting with this program. FSET is operated through Workforce Resource, Inc.

- There are no limitations based on location this is a state-wide program.
- The grant ends on July 1, 2025

• Students must meet the age requirement for Nursing Assistant training (be at least 16 years old) – WisCaregiver Careers does not have any outside age requirements for individuals to participate. This grant is available to high school students.

BENEFITS TO STUDENTS:

- This program provides free training (including tuition and books), free certification testing and \$500 sign-on or retention bonuses
- Employers are encouraged to upskill their existing employees by offering training and testing reimbursement for incumbent workers
- Qualified candidates will be referred, by Workforce Resource/FSET. to participating employers for hiring consideration
