WITC-Rice Lake WISCONSIN STATE TELECOMMUNICATIONS FOUNDATION (WSTF) BROADBAND ACADEMY GRANTS

Overview:

The Wisconsin State Telecommunications Foundation (WSTF) has designated **four grants of \$250 each** for students in the Broadband Academy program on the Rice Lake campus. There will be two grants awarded each semester. Students are eligible to apply one month after courses start.

Procedures:

- 1. The campus Broadband Academy instructor refers the student to the program coordinator.
- 2. Student connects with the program coordinator to discuss eligibility.
 - a. The program coordinator will recommend approval for grants after reviewing the Requirements & Eligibility portion on page 2. WSTF Broadband Academy Grants will be limited to a maximum of \$250.
 - b. Recommendations for *Broadband Academy Grants* must be submitted to a Foundation representative from the program coordinator via the *WITC Foundation Application for Other Student Assistance* form.
- 3. After review and approval of the completed application, the Foundation representative will provide student information to WSTF for payment.

Grant Requirements & Eligibility:

- 1. Applicants must be taking one course in any of the courses listed below.
- 2. Applicants should be employed or live in service area of a WSTA member.
- 3. If you are in AT&T, CenturyLink, Spring Valley Telephone Company or West Wisconsin Telcom Cooperative service areas, you are **not eligible** to apply for a WSTF grant.
- 4. Academic excellence is taken into consideration but is not paramount to receiving one of the grants
- 5. The primary considerations are the student has: (1) expressed a sincere desire to continue his or her education in the broadband field; (2) demonstrated the ability to excel in the broadband field; and (3) financial need.
- 6. Each student can only receive one WSTF grant.
- 7. Student is not eligible if course is paid for from a broadband/telecom company.
