

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Between

Grantham University and Wisconsin Indianhead Technical College

1. Purpose

The purpose of this articulation agreement between Wisconsin Indianhead Technical College hereinafter "WITC", and Grantham University, Inc., hereinafter "Grantham University" is to facilitate student progress towards their educational and career goals by simplifying the transfer of academic credits between the two institutions. This document establishes transfer criteria for undergraduate credit earned at Wisconsin Indianhead Technical College to be utilized towards earning a degree at Grantham University.

2. The Articulation Agreement

Grantham University and WITC each formally recognize the professional integrity and academic stature of the other. Both institutions view the other as active educational partners, committed to providing greater educational opportunities and services for students transferring between institutions.

This commitment strongly supports the concept of seamless transfer that embraces the principle that transfer students should not be required to repeat competencies already achieved. Residency requirements remain in effect for each institution as published in its respective college catalog.

Grantham University and WITC enter into this agreement in the spirit of cooperation and mutually recognize each other as high-quality institutions of higher learning.

3. Equivalent Courses or Programs

Grantham University WITC recognize the courses and/or programs listed in this document as equivalent and will accept them as equivalent programs, general education courses, major courses, prerequisites, and electives as indicated.

4. Longevity of the Agreement

This articulation agreement entered into by Grantham University and WITC has no termination date, but the agreed upon transfers will be reviewed every two years. If there is a significant change to the curriculum of a degree program by either party, a request for reconsideration of one or more points must be submitted as a written change request signed by the respective officers of each institution. Termination of this agreement by either educational partner must be submitted in writing to the other partner three months prior to the identified cancellation date in order to protect all students transferring between these institutions. Both parties agree that failure to maintain accreditation will be grounds for termination of this agreement.

5. Promotion

Each institution may refer to this agreement in its respective literature including its website, provided that it does not violate the business standards policy of its accrediting body. For the purposes of promotion each institution is granted a nonexclusive right to display both institution's trademark logos, name, and copyright symbols. The logo, symbols, and company name may be used ONLY in reference to the parameters agreed to in this agreement.

Each institution agrees not to use the logo, name, or copyright symbols in any way to indicate that it has any ownership or control of the other institution, its brands and products. Each institution further agrees not to use the logo, name, or copyright symbols in any way that would harm, diminish, or impair the other institution's sales, prospects, brand name or reputation. This agreement does not allow either institution to sublicense the other institution's trademark logos, name, and/or copyright symbols. This agreement does not constitute an acquisition of a source trademark.

6. Commitment

Wisconsin Indianhead Technical College and Grantham University are committed to serve our students and use technology to facilitate the transfer of students between institutions. Students participating in the program must meet all criteria for admission to either Grantham University or WITC and comply with all requirements in the awarding of a degree. This articulation agreement is signed this 16th day of October between Grantham University and Wisconsin Indianhead Technical College.
